IMPORTANT CHECKLIST FOR PARTICIPANTS

Please read through your packet thoroughly!

Make a copy of this sheet for the driver or main contact for your float.

Thank you so much for participating in the Festival of Lights Parade! Our goal is to create a wonderful and safe holiday experience for the community. You play a key role in achieving this. Please adhere to the following rules. If you have any questions, visit our website at www.festivaloflightsrc.com or call (605) 381-4204.

- Return your *Float Description Form* no later than Monday, November 25.** The *Float Description Form* is included in this packet.
- You must enter the Staging Area from East St. Patrick Street between 4 p.m. and 5 p.m. for check-in and line-up.** Line-up order will be on a first-in, first-out basis. You will be directed by Parade Officials; please follow their instructions to avoid delays. **Animal units will stage in designated areas.** Please contact Connie Olson (605) 381-4204 if you are unsure of your staging location.
- No live Santas!** Santa will ride on a float determined by the committee and he will be the final float in the parade.
- No walkers!** Entries travel 3 miles along unlit streets that may be wet and icy. Walkers are unable to keep pace with moving vehicles or stay warm.
- You must have a Type-2ABC Fire Extinguisher** on your float. This will be verified by our check-in crew. Please have a representative with your entry at all times.
- Display the float number (which you'll be provided)** on the passenger side of the windshield of the tow vehicle.
- No candy or other items may be handed out or thrown before, during, or after the parade.** This is a safety issue and will be strictly enforced.
- Non-parade vehicles are not allowed in the Staging Area.**
- The parade will begin at 6 p.m. at Main Street and East Boulevard. All entries will exit the Parade Route by continuing east on St. Joe Street to East St. Patrick Street.**

FOR SAFETY REASONS, NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO RIDE ON THE ROOFTOPS OF VEHICLES!
