Return your Float Description Form no later than Monday, November 20. The Float Description Form is included in this packet.	
You must enter the Staging Area from East St. Patrick Street between 4 and 5 p.m. for check-in and line-up. Line-up order will be on a first in, first out basis. You will be directed by Parade Officials—please follow their instructions to avoid delays. Animal units will stage in designated areas. Please contact Connie Olson (605) 340-0914 if you are unsure of your staging location.	
No live Santas! Santa will ride on a float determined by the committee, and he will be the final float in the parade.	
No walkers! Entries travel 3 miles along unlit streets that may be wet and icy. Walkers are unable to keep pace with moving vehicles or stay warm.	
You must have a Type-2ABC Fire Extinguisher on your float. This will be verified by our check-in crew. Please have a representative with your entry at all times.	
Display the float number (which you'll provided) on the passenger side of the windshield of the tow vehicle.	
No candy or other items may be handed out or thrown before, during, or after the Parade. This is a safety issue and will be strictly enforced!	
Non-parade vehicles are not allowed in the Staging Area.	
The Parade will begin at 6 p.m. at Main Street and East Boulevard. All entries will exit the Parade Route by continuing east on St. Joe Street to East St. Patrick Street.
